ASSEMBLY

1 Print the visual schedule symbol cards and schedule boards. You can print on regular computer paper or on cardstock. I recommend selecting "Scale to fit paper" when printing to avoid anything being cut off the edges.



2 Laminate the cards. I typically laminate before cutting out pieces, but if you want extra durability, you can cut out pieces and then laminate.



3 Cut out all pieces. I like using a paper cutter to make this step easier and faster.



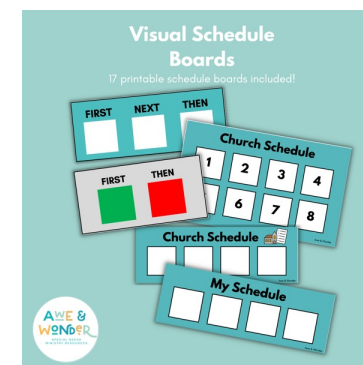
4 Add Velcro dots to the schedule cards. I like to use the soft side of Velcro for all parts of a resource that will be stationary and the rough side on the movable pieces. This allows the movable pieces to be used across different resources.



5 Attach cards to a visual schedule board and use!

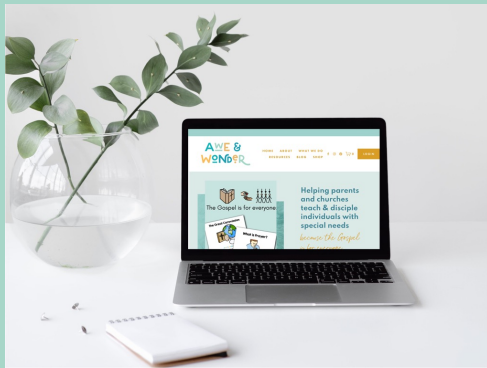

If purchasing these supplies isn't in your budget right now, here are some tips.

- 1) Staples and other office supplies stores can laminate for you. It's usually \$1-\$2 per page.
- 2) In a pinch, you can "laminat" with thick packing tape on each side of the paper. I recommend printing on cardstock if you go this route.
- 3) You can use sticky tack to attach schedule cards to the boards if you do not have Velcro on hand. For long term use/storage, I recommend getting Velcro.

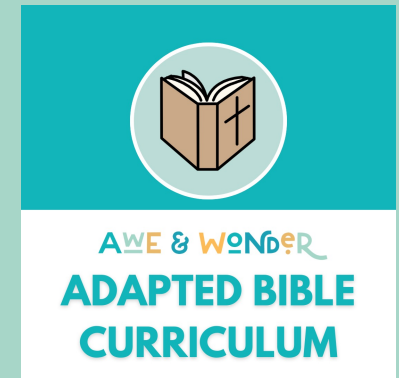
