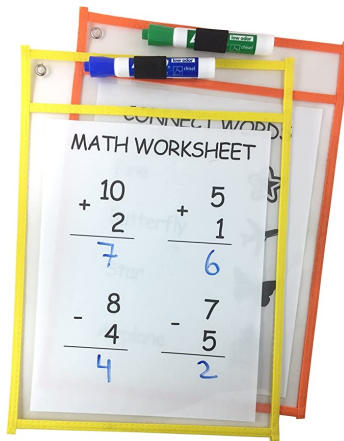

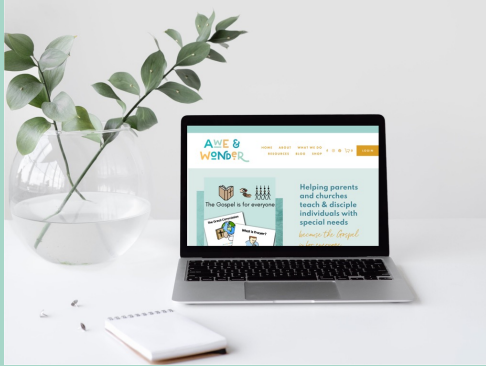


**TIP: LEAVE A BLANK SPACE FOR NOTES**

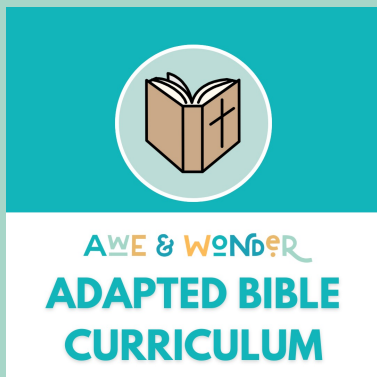
