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RESURRECT

Jesus is the son of God, who came to earth and was fully man and fully God. Jesus lived a perfect life. He never sins, but took on the sins of the world so that we may be made righteous with God. He was innocent. He would died for our wrongs. But would he stay died? No. He was be rised from the dead , or “resurrected.” The word resurrect literally means to be rised from the dead.
