## 01

### **SPIRITUALLY**

### **RELATIONALLY**

Communication challenges can hinder Deaf individuals from forming meaningful relationships, emphasizing the importance of accessible communication in fostering community.

## 03

### **PHYSICALLY**

Physical spaces that lack visual aids or clear signage create barriers for Deaf individuals, highlighting the need for environments that accommodate all forms of communication.

## 04

### **FINANCIALLY**

Deaf individuals often encounter financial barriers due to limited job opportunities and additional costs for interpreting services, highlighting the need for equitable access to economic resources.

## 05

### **LINGUISTICALLY**

Without access to sign language and other communication methods, Deaf individuals are often excluded from important conversations, making language access crucial for inclusion.
